Create a Paper Plate Swan

What you will need:

- Paper Plate
- White and Pink Paper
- Black Marker or Paper
- Scissors
- Glue stick





Steps:

- 1. Cut the Paper Plate: Take a paper plate and cut it in half. Use one half as the body of the bird and save the other half for another project.
- 2. Shape the Neck and Head: Cut out a curved shape from the top of the paper plate half to form the bird's neck and head, leaving the bottom part of the plate as the body.
- 3. Make the Beak: Cut a small triangle from pink paper to make the bird's beak. Glue the pink beak onto the top of the neck, near the rounded end for the head.
- 4. Add the Eye: Use a black marker to draw an eye, or cut a small circle from black paper and glue it on to create the bird's eye.
- 5. Create the Wings: Cut a wing shape from white paper and glue it onto the body of the bird to give it a feathery look.
- 6. Finishing Touches: Add any extra details or decorations if you like, such as coloring the bird or adding feathers.

Now, your paper plate bird is ready! You can hang it on the wall or use it as decoration.
