

Simple Craft: Weaving a Potholder with the Made By Me Ultimate Weaving Loom

Hey adults! We LOVE this weaving craft to compliment our Season 1 finale, Emperor's New Clothes. Unfortunately you will need to purchase this craft kit, but we linked out to the least expensive one! We can't wait to see your creations!

#### Materials Needed:

- Made By Me Ultimate Weaving Loom
- Cotton loops (included with the loom kit)
- Crochet hook (included with the loom kit)
- Scissors

#### Instructions:

### Step 1: Set Up the Loom

- 1. Place the loom flat on a table.
- 2. Choose the colors of cotton loops you want to use for your potholder.

### Step 2: Warp the Loom

1. Stretch a loop horizontally across the loom, hooking it onto the pegs at the top and bottom.



2. Repeat until all the pegs on one side are filled, creating the "warp" threads.

# Step 3: Weave the Loops

- 1. Take a new loop and stretch it across the loom vertically, weaving it over and under the horizontal loops.
- 2. Use the crochet hook to help guide the loop through the warp.
- 3. Hook the loop onto the side pegs to secure it.
- 4. Alternate the pattern (over-under, under-over) for each new loop to create a woven effect.
- 5. Continue until all the pegs on the other side are filled.

## Step 4: Secure the Edges

- 1. Carefully remove the loops from the pegs one by one.
- 2. Use the crochet hook to pull one loop through the next, forming a chain stitch around the edge.
- 3. Continue this process all the way around the loom.
- 4. Tie off the last loop securely with a knot.

## Step 5: Trim and Finish

- 1. Trim any loose ends of the loops with scissors.
- 2. Gently stretch and shape your woven potholder.

### **Optional:** Personalize!

- Add a colorful border by weaving additional loops around the edges.
- Use alternating colors for a fun striped or checkered design.

This craft is simple, creative, and perfect for kids!
